EUROSATORY 2022 INTERNATIONAL EXHIBITION Discover the actors and the expertise of the Ministry of Interior

Eurosatory is the international exhibition dedicated to land and air defense and security. This unmissable event brings together professionals from all over the world in charge of these two sectors. It will be held from June 13 to 17 at the Paris Nord Villepinte exhibition center.

The Ministry of Interior participates in this leading event, where more than 1,800 exhibitors from over 60 countries present a variety of equipment, vehicles and systems dedicated to peacekeeping and security.

A 392 square meters stand, located at H5B C-251, will group together four thematic clusters, which will enable members of the Ministry of the Interior's directorates and units to show French expertise in security and policing. Dynamic demonstrations are also planned outside.

The four thematic hubs on the stand are:

Counter-terrorism:

The operational chain dedicated to the treatment of nuclear, radiological, biological and chemical (NRBC) risks and accidents is highlighted with the presentation of the missions and equipment of the national NRBC force (F2NRBC) and the French Gendarmerie intervention squad (GIGN).

Two virtual reality films will also be presented to experience a parachute jump and a GIGN intervention.

The RAID, an elite intervention unit of the French National Police, will show its expertise in the field of anti-drone warfare by presenting its fast operational anti-drone vehicle (VADOR), its suitcase and its discreet anti-drone backpack (SACAD).

The teams of the Research and Intervention Brigade (BRI), which will also offer a full-scale demonstration on Thursday, June 16, 2022, will represent the Regional Directorate of Judicial Police (DRPJ).

Security and public order:

The French National Gendarmerie will present the Centaure vehicle, which is the new Gendarmerie's armored vehicle, as well as several outfits designed to ensure law enforcement missions.

The Paris Police Prefecture will also be present on the Ministry of the Interior stand. The Directorate of Public Order and Traffic (DOPC) will present a BRAV-M crew and their vehicle. The Directorate of Innovation, Logistics and Technology (DILT) will be exhibiting innovative tools dedicated to policing management.

Civil Security:

The demining intervention group (GID) and the helicopter group will represent the General Directorate for Civil Security and Crisis Management (DGSCGC). Deminers will present to visitors their missions and their equipment, including the heavy suit and the intervention robot Teodor. Dragon pilots will be on hand to talk to professionals and journalists about the new H145 helicopter, a model which will be on exhibition at the stand.

With 8,500 men and women, the Paris Fire Brigade (BSPP) is the largest fire department in Europe and the third largest in the world. Eurosatory allows this elite corps to demonstrate its expertise and present its operational capabilities and innovations, entirely developed in partnership with French manufacturers.

Visitors will be able to discover extinguishing and support robots for specialized crews, geolocation systems, rapid intervention motorcycles and two models of drones.

International:

The Directorate for International Security Cooperation (DCIS) participates in the implementation of France's foreign policy in areas under the responsibility of the Ministry of Interior. As the world's leading international police cooperation network, the DCIS works, among other things, to ensure that France's economic diplomacy policy runs smoothly. It facilitates exchanges between French companies and local authorities, in strict compliance with competition laws.

Foreign delegations who come to Eurosatory to meet with French companies likely to satisfy their needs in terms of homeland security and civilian equipment will be accompanied by the DCIS partnership division. The export support mission of this division is governed by the ethical charter regulating relations between the French business communities and the DCIS.

The Ministerial Delegation for Security Partnerships, Strategies and Innovations (DPSIS) will present the steering of Franco-Singaporean cooperation on homeland security technologies, the French industrial strategy for the security industrial and technological base, the Ministry's position in the fight against cyber threats, as well as the steering of the security technology experimentation program for the major events of 2023 and 2024.
